Parent Home Access Center

Home Access Center is a student database which allows parents to access student grades, discipline information, etc., so that parents can be informed and made aware of their children's progress.

Please be advised that the Class Work/Grades tab of the Home Access Center will be enabled for parent access on Tuesday,

September 6, 2011. You will use the same login and password for the Home Access Center each year as long as you have at least one child active in Fulton County Schools. If your child has been withdrawn or has graduated from the school system, your Home Access Center login is inactivated automatically by the

system and you will no longer have access to the site. Teachers have sent home the login information for this site this week. If you did not receive it, you may bring picture identification to the front office beginning Sept. 12th to retrieve your login and password.

NEWS YOU CAN USE:

- Students must arrive at school by 7:25 a.m. in order to get a school breakfast.
- If you have not completed the Affidavit of Residence form and returned it to the school, please do so before September 15, 2011. Students who do not have the forms on file will be withdrawn by that date.
- Students should not wear sandals/flip flops to school on days they will have P.E.

A Minute from the Clinic with Nurse Potts

Don't let backpacks get you down! When used correctly, backpacks are the best way to carry a heavy load, especially for long period of time. But they should never weigh more than 10 to 15 percent of the child's weight. For instance, a child who weighs 100 pounds should have a backpack weighing no more than 10 to 15 pounds. **If a child has to lean forward to support the weight of his backpack it is too heavy.**

Proper use of a backpack helps evenly distribute the weight. Straps should be wide and padded. Children should always wear both straps over their shoulders and a waist strap, if provided. Adjust the straps so that the backpack rests in the middle of the child's back. Always pack the backpack with the most weight lower on the back, near the waist, and with the heaviest books closest to the body.

Children should clean out their backpacks regularly to remove unnecessary items. Also, they should bend their knees to pick up a backpack instead of leaning over. Parents, please take the time to choose the correct backpack size for your child(ren).
