SPLOST IV Refresh. Rebuild. Renew.



The Fulton County School System has called for a referendum for citizens to consider the continuation of a Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST). SPLOST has funded capital needs in the Fulton County School System since 1997. Previous SPLOST

programs have funded 37 new schools, 28 school additions and multiple projects such as roof replacement, HVAC renovations, floor covering replacements, surveillance camera installations and playfield enhancements.

A significant portion of SPLOST IV will be dedicated to school level and system

wide enhancement of technology. SPLOST IV goes beyond bricks and mortar by funding new computers for students and teachers, distance learning in all high schools and high speed networks and Internet access.

Voting day is Tuesday, November 8, 2011 from 7:00 a.m. to 7 p.m.
